

Tag Test Unit Instructions



- Make sure the test station is plugged in
- Hold your tag within 10-30cm of the unit
 - Only the green tag seen should light up
 - o If the amber low battery lights up, request a new tag
 - If red tag clash light is on, there is another tag within the field, and your test will not be registered
- If tag seen light is on, battery low light is off and no tag clash light then you can accept the test

Important notes

- Tags should be tested in accordance with site procedures. It is recommend this is done at least once per day or shift
- If a tag suffers any mechanical shock or you are concerned it may not be working correctly it should be tested and if necessary replaced immediately
- If the tag shows any signs of mechanical damage such as the case being cracked or broken replace it
- SiteZone is to only be used as a complement to existing health and safety measures.
 It is not a replacement for existing operating aids and/or health and safety practices. It is to be used to bring the vehicle operators attention to the presence of tag wearing personnel.
